THE PUPOSE OF MARRIAGE

■ Marriage has purpose!

■ Companionship (Gen. 2:18)

- “. . .as being heirs together of the grace of life. . .” (1 Pet. 3:7, NKJV)
- “. . . Yet she is your companion And your wife by covenant” (Mal. 2:14, NKJV)

THE PURPOSE OF MARRIAGE

■ MARRIAGE HAS PURPOSE!

- Companionship (Gen. 2:18)
- To produce godly offspring
 - “But did He not make them one, Having a remnant of the Spirit? And why one? **He seeks godly offspring**. Therefore take heed to your spirit, And let none deal treacherously with the wife of his youth” (Mal. 2:15, NKJV)

I Corinthians 7:1-5

- Let the husband render to his wife v.3

 - **“Due” “a debt that is to be paid” v.3**
