Forbidden Fruit...Bad Jam

Last week I read a witty statement: “Forbidden fruit is responsible for many a bad jam.” Like it or not, every day brings the challenge of temptation, the potential of sin and the threat of damnation (1 Peter 5:8-9). So what happens?

“Each man is tempted, when he is drawn away by his own lust and enticed. Then, the lust, when it hath conceived, beareth sin and the sin, when it is full grown, bringeth forth death (James 1:14 -15).

1. Temptation is **SURE**. “Each man is tempted, when-- “no ifs, ands but or maybes”. The word is *when*. Temptation is a part of life. You and I might as well get ready for it.
2. Temptation is **SUBTLE**. We are “drawn away.” The devil doesn't slap us in the face with the possibility of sin. He doesn't throw a cold bucket of potential iniquity on the backside of our neck. He sneaks up on us.
3. Temptation is **SPECIALIZED**. It is custom made from our “own lusts”. That makes me my own worst enemy if I don't learn to deny self.
4. Temptation is **SEDUCTIVE**. Before, we know it, we are “enticed” by our own desires. The devil doesn't coerce, push or force. He lures us into sin, tantalizing us with our own wants and wishes.
5. Temptation is responsible for **SIN** and **SEPERATION**. It “beareth sin” and “bringeth forth death.” Who is responsible? The devil. He is the one who weaves together the situations of life with our personal desires, creating a tapestry of temptation. But wait.... you and I are also to blame because we say “yes” to our own desires.

The devil is for real and he is very busy. Just look at the world about. Better still, feel the bitter sting of temptation within.

But, let's close on a happy note--a promise:

“Blessed is the man that endureth temptation; for when he hath been approved, he shall receive the crown of life which the Lord promised to them that love Him” (James 1:12”.
