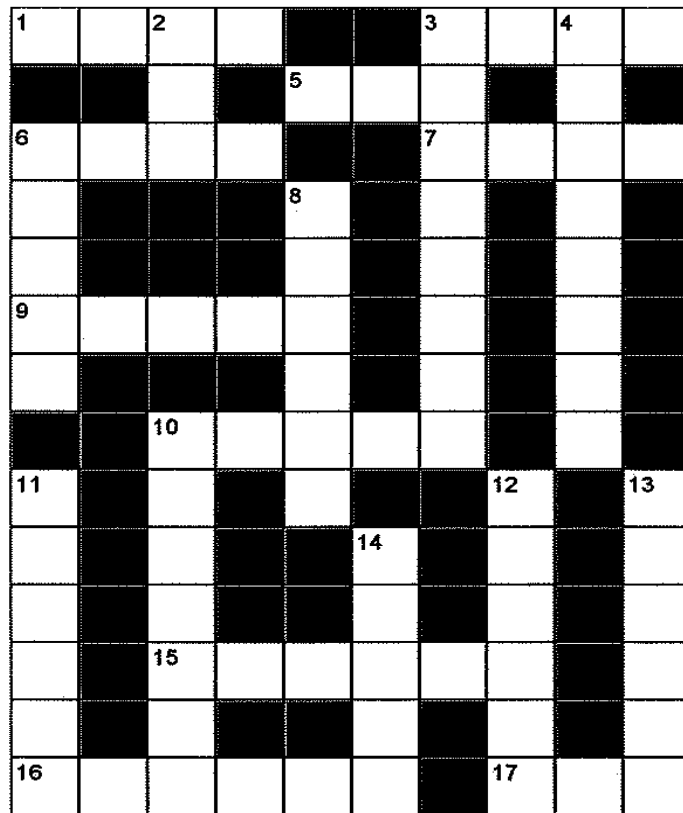

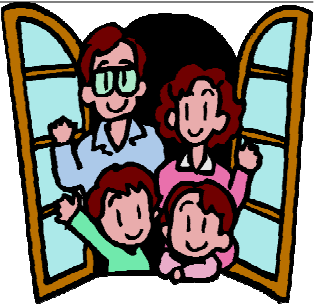

PLANTING THE SEED

Last Lord's Day evening we heard brother Cy Stafford speak to us about the work in Tanzania, East Africa. It was thrilling to hear about the number of souls saved through the preaching of the gospel. It made me stop and think about what we can do when we work together. God said in 1 Corinthians 3:9 "For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building." Think about it, as we yield ourselves to His will He can use us to reach the lost in East Africa.

Our theme for 2009 is "Plant The Seed". Everything that we support, everything that we do is designed to plant the seed, which is the word of God.
