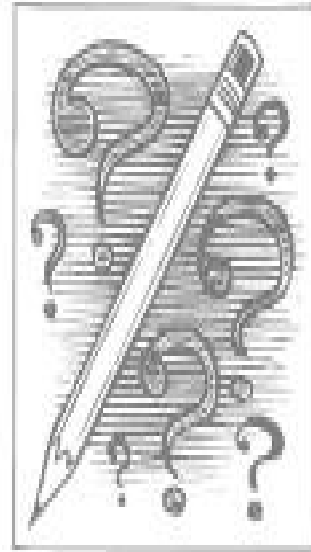

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE TEACH ABOUT THE HOME AND FAMILY? By Garland Robinson

So many families are in serious trouble today. Marriage is entered into with little concern for a life-long commitment and partnership. God has not changed His will regarding the home and family in these modern times. Notice some things the Bible says about the home and family.

1) **The home is the creation of God.** First Timothy 4:1-5 says God created it for them which believe and know the truth. Man knew nothing of the home until God gave it to him (see Genesis 2). It is not man-made; therefore, man does not have the right to dissolve it or do with it as he pleases. The home is sacred. Everyone must revere the home and count it precious.

2) **The home was instituted by God at the beginning of human history.** God said, “*It is not good that the man should be alone.*” It was God who made the woman for the man. It was God who presented her to the man. And, it was God who said, “*For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and the two shall be one flesh*” (Genesis 2:18-24). The home is as old as man himself. Both man and the home began the same day.

3) **The home is a sacred arrangement in which the husband and wife are bound together until separated by death.** Marriage is a life-time proposition (Romans 7:1-4). Each one vows to live as husband and wife “till death do us part.” The vows in marriage involve “for better or for worse,” “for richer or poorer,” “in sickness and in health.” With so many, they say these words but do not mean them. The two who enter marriage “cleave” to each other. To separate from one another is not the will of God (Luke 16:18)!

4) **The home exists for distinct purposes.** It is for personal self-completion (Genesis 2:18). The man and the woman are each incomplete without the other. Marriage is for the purpose of avoiding immorality (I Corinthians 7:2-4). Sex outside of marriage is SIN. Marriage helps us have a better understanding of the relationship between Christ and His church (Ephesians 5:21-33). The home is divine!
