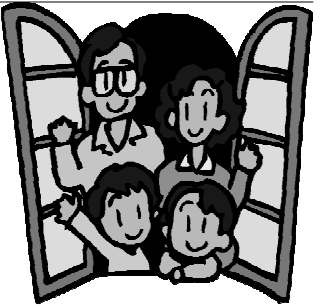

I KNOW THAT GOD WILL JUDGE By Barry Gilreth

How can a loving God who desires all men to be saved bring judgment? I do not know. I know that God is holy (Lev. 19:2). I know that God is just (Rom. 3:26). I also know that all of the facets of his nature work together in harmony. But I will never be able to answer all of the questions that arise as we all try to understand the harmony within that amazing diversity.

But the point of this study is to remind us, that we do not need to answer all of those questions. We just need to respect the guideposts that God has given us.

If your understanding of God leads you to make the statement, “I just don’t believe that a loving God would ever send someone to hell,” you need to read and trust the scriptures anew. If you struggle in coming to grips with this conflict, it is wholly understandable. Anyone who tells you they have every answer to this conflict is naïve or too prideful.

You have good reason to reflect and meditate on these things. But let me encourage you to stay within the markers God has left us. The same Bible from which you have been convicted that God wants to save you is the same book that pointedly says that God has fixed a day in which he will judge the world.

It is not our calling to explain every mystery of God—although we should never stop trying. No, it is our mission to live in view of what we do know.

I know a day of judgment is coming. I do not know when it is. I do not fully understand why it is. But it is my passion to live because it is. One day I will stand before his throne to have my life examined. The sentence he proclaims will determine my eternal fate. That is what the Bible teaches.

It teaches it for you also. Judgment is coming. And only until that day or until your life ends will you have an opportunity to prepare. Get ready.

But do so in hope. The guideposts we have already examined provide hope. You will be judged. But you will be judged by a God who is infinite in love and wants nothing more than to save your soul.
