## LORD, WHO IS MY FRIEND

To a Christian, friends are very important, because they can help you feel good when you are down, they can help you get through the tough things in life, if they are a Christian they can help you grow spiritually (fellowship), and the list can go on and on. But the last few months I learned a very, very important lesson: You CAN NOT have the friendship or relationship that you want....with an individual that does not want that kind of friendship that you want to have. It is impossible!!

We've all heard of David and Goliath, but do you remember about David and King Saul? If so, continue reading please...if not, still continue reading, please. David the son of Jesse the Bethlehemite. (1 Sam. 17:58), who killed Goliath with only a sling or sling shot. David's great win over killing Goliath caused a disturbance in his relationship with Saul. Things was pretty good between David and Saul for a while, until things went down the drain when David returned from slaughtering the Philistines and women started singing "Saul has killed his thousands, and David his ten thousands" (1 Sam. 18:6-7). This made Saul very, very envious (1 Sam. 18:8-9). Some short time later, Saul tried to Kill David with a javelin (1 Sam. 18:10-11). Later Saul repented and swore to Jonathan, Saul's son, that he will not kill David (1 Sam. 19:5-6)...which was a lie. We see in 1 Samuel 24:1-4 that Saul went into a cave where David and his men was hiding. David had a chance to kill King Saul, but didn't do so...but he did cut off his robe for evidence because David didn't want to hurt King Saul (1 Sam. 24:9-10) Also on another time David did the same thing in 1 Samuel 12; King Saul was camping and David and one of his men went in to where Saul was sleeping. David did not kill Saul, but took his spear and jug of water near his pillow for evidence because he did not want to kill Saul.

When I first read 1 Samuel, I asked myself this question: Why didn't David try and kill King Saul? My first answer was that David wanted his relationship with King Saul back again. (there maybe more of a definite reason(s) why David didn't killed Saul...this is only my first thought) Saul found favor in David "And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer. 22 And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight." (1 Samuel 16:21-22). David never tried to outdo King Saul. He went to the battle, where Goliath was, on his Father's orders to give food to David's brothers (1 Sam. 17:17-19). David acted wisely, not greedy of power or anything. We see this in 1 Sam. 18:5,14,30. You see like David and King Saul you CAN NOT have the friendship or relationship that you want....with an individual that does not want that kind of friendship that you want to have. To make this note have more application we need to let go of the people who do not want to be a Christian...there are others out there that you can be converted. Likewise there are other people out there who want a friendship like you want. For a side note Jonathan, Saul's son, was good or best friends with David..."Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul." 1 Samuel 18:3.

You know I don't believe in best friends because people will get jealous, but I do have close friends. And I TRY to be fair and friendly with all people. When somebody calls my cell, I try to answer it because you never know what the other person on the other end needs/wants you for and I answer, just, because they want to talk to me...my friend needs/wants me! What I'm trying to say is I value all my friends! But we have a greater....
