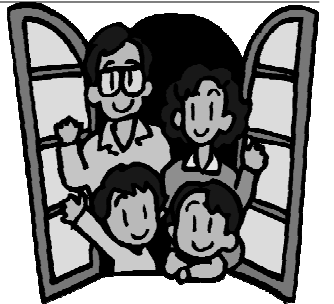

## WILL JESUS RETURN TO THIS EARTH?

The theme of the Old Testament is that a savior, a messiah, is coming. He would bring deliverance from sins and thereby redeem sinful man (Joel 2:32; Obadiah 1:17).

In Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, we read of his coming. He lived a sinless life (Hebrews 7:26) and died for sinful man (Romans 5:6-8; 6:10). Before Jesus left this world he promised he would come again (John 14:3; cf. II Thessalonians 2:1; Heb. 9:28). As Christians partake of the Lord's supper each first day of the week (the Lord's day) we "shew *the Lord's death till he come*" (I Corinthians 11:26). Yes, the Lord is coming again.

HOWEVER, contrary to what many believe, he will never set foot upon this earth again. His second coming will be to bring all things on this earth to an end (I Corinthians 15:22-24). The earth and all upon it will be burned up and melted with fervent heat (II Peter 3:10). His coming again will be to judge all mankind, both the good and the bad (Matthew 25:31-46; II Corinthians 5:10). Faithful Christians are told to hold fast till he comes (Revelation 2:25).

The disciples who witnessed the Lord's ascension into heaven were told by angels of the manner of his return. It would be as he left this earth, in the clouds (Acts 1:9-11). Revelation 1:7 says, "*Behold, he cometh with clouds.*" "*When Christ...shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory*" (Colossians 3:4). "*For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven...the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord*" (II Thessalonians 4:16-17). As we see the Lord in the clouds, we will meet him there. He will never set foot on this earth again. Are you ready for that day?

When the Lord came in the first century, he accomplished all that he came to do. He lived so as to leave us an example to follow his steps (I Peter 2:21). He made himself a sacrifice for the sins of all mankind (Hebrews 2:9). On the cross he said, "it is finished" (John 19:30). His work on earth was done. His kingdom, the church, was established (Acts 2:1-4). When he comes again it will be to take it home to heaven. Only the kingdom/church will be saved.
