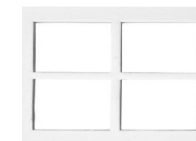

Stop Worrying and Start Living

“Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat or what ye shall drink, nor yet for your body, what shall ye put on. Is not the life more than meat and the body than raiment?”

A far more concise translation of the phrase, “Take no thought for your life” would be “Do not be anxious for your life”: better yet... “Do not worry for your life.”

Worry is one of the chief causes of discontentment in most of our lives and as Christians, this should not be. However, a solution to this mortifying problem can be summed up in this simple statement that I borrowed from a contemporary author: “Stop worrying and invite God into the details of your life.”

Worrying is one of the most destructive of human habits because it kills our effectiveness in other areas. When we worry about something, our thoughts and emotions are focused on events that have not yet happened.

Worry is totally passive. It accomplishes nothing. It can literally make you sick while keeping you from accomplishing the things that really matter.

Here is a sobering thought: Worry can keep you from living your life as God intended it.

When you think about the things you worry about, you will be amazed to learn that you probably worry about the small stuff. Those details of life over which you have little or no control.

Worrying is a sign of unbelief! When we worry, it means that we do not believe that God can take care of the practical details of our lives, and it is hardly ever anything but those details that we worry about.

Jesus asked this rhetorical question in Matt. 6:27, “Which of you, by being anxious, can add one cubit to his stature?” In other words, can all your worry add a single moment to your life? Of course not! If anything, worrying can and will take away from your life.

Consider this, are you trying to arrange the details of your life so carefully that you are leaving God out of the process? If so, then you are worrying too much. You are relying on your own abilities and you think you have a lot to lose if things don't turn out the way you want or think they should.

Nevertheless, it is clear that the antidote to worry is trusting God to take care of the small stuff of your life. Invite Him to get involved in the details of your life as you remember the words of Peter, “Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He careth for you (1 Peter 5:6-7).
